12/14/1895 - Bertie is born (34th anniversary of the death of his great grandfather, Prince Albert, from typhoid)

- 1913-1919 Bertie's naval service
- 6/4/1920 Bertie given the title of Duke of York, Earl of Inverness, and
- Baron Killarney by King George V
- 4/26/1923 Bertie's marriage to Elizabeth Bowes-Lyon
- 1926 Bertie meets Speech Therapist Lionel Logue
- 1926 Bertie plays doubles tennis at Wimbledon
- 1926 Princess Elizabeth is born (later Queen Elizabeth II)
- 1930 Princess Margaret is born
- 1930 Edward meets Wallis Simpson
- 1/20/1936 King George V Dies/Edward becomes King Edward VIII
- 12/11/1936 Edward abdicates the throne/Bertie becomes King George VI
- 5/12/1937 Bertie's coronation
- 6/3/1937 Edward marries Wallis Simpson in France
- Oct. 1937 Edward and Wallis meet Hitler in Germany
- May 1939 Bertie visits the United States (First U.K. monarch to visit the U.S.)
- 9/1/1939 Start of World War II
- 1940 Edward sent to the Bahamas as Governor
- 9/7/1940 Blitz bombings start on London
- 9/13/1940 Buckingham Palace bombed
- 9/2/1945 World War II ends
- Jan. 1946 Bertie addresses the first United Nations' Assembly
- 9/23/1951 Bertie undergoes surgery; left lung removed due to malignant tumor
- 2/6/1952 Bertie (King George VI) dies/Princess Elizabeth becomes

Queen Elizabeth II

6/2/1953 - Elizabeth's coronation
